## Divot Diggings

We have experienced an interesting weather season this year. Since the Michigan Open ended on June 11 we have had a total of 2.9 inches of rain.

2.7 inches of that came in a four day period from June 17 thru June 20. We are fast approaching an entire month with almost zero rain. The real savior has been the cooler temperatures, especially at night allowing some to be replenished with the irrigation system. If this keeps up you can expect to see areas start to become very stressed which do not have good irrigation coverage or none at all.

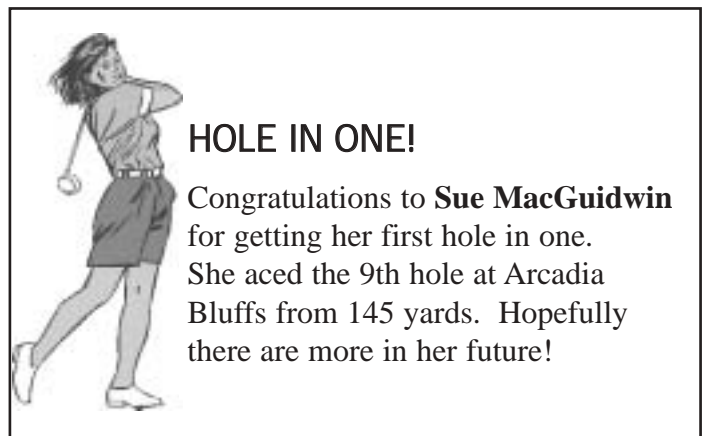
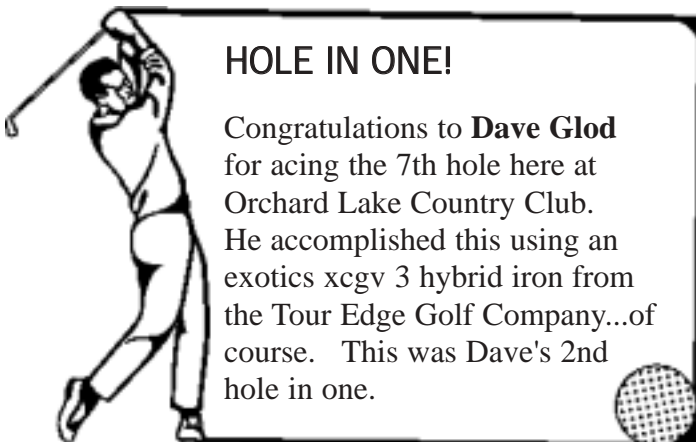
Over the past week we raised the mowing heights on greens from .130" to .140" to relieve some of the stress the turf has endured over the past three weeks. We had too much regulation on greens during the Michigan Open and we had to let the greens come completely out of this and they grow a lot when the rebound effect finally hits. This comes at the expense of our root system which shrank considerable over the last three weeks.

Bunkers have been very wet lately do to running the irrigation system attempting to keep the faces in good condition. This is another of the underlying problems with our bunker system. When we reach a period of extreme dry weather the bunker faces must be watered excessively to keep them from burning up. The bunkers that have not been repaired with increased in drainage will hold water and become dirty and very wet. We till the bunkers once a week and during this period have even tilled them twice per week to try and relieve the moisture.

We have three demo mats now on the range tee. We would like everyone to evaluate the three mats for quality of use. There will be a sign at each mat letting you know which mat you are hitting from and there will be a sheet in your locker room bulletin board to list your mat preference.

I hope everyone is enjoying their summer at the club.

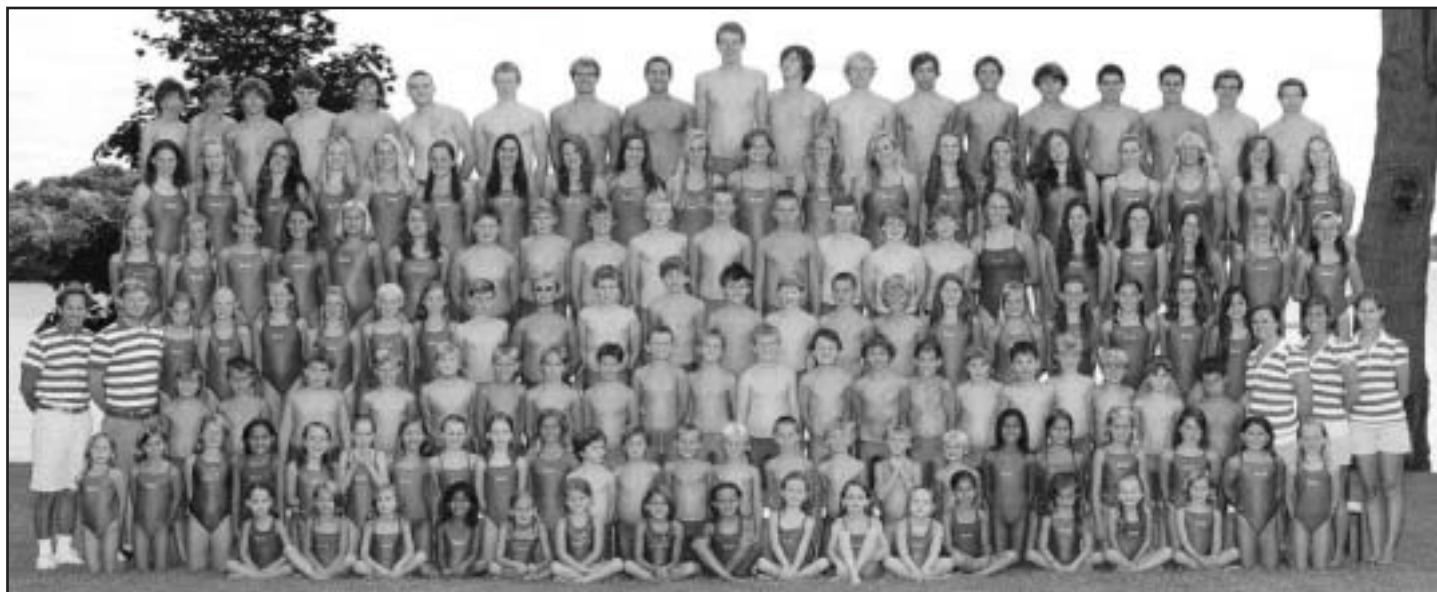
